Position Responsibilities

- Responsible to conduct interactive & educational STEM/Maker Space programs for children of all ages
- Student may be required to learn some basic library procedures

- Must be familiar with and able to teach STEM/Makerspace concepts (robotics, circuits, electronics etc.)
